## **UNITED STATES, DOMINO'S YOU TUBE VIDEO**

A video is currently circulating on the internet showing two Domino's Pizza LLC (Domino's United States) employees' behaving inappropriately, this was an isolated incident in Conover, North Carolina USA.

The employees involved had their employment terminated effective immediately and have since been arrested under a felony warrant. The store has been shut down and sanitised from top to bottom.

Even though these employees were acting in front of the camera and no food was served to any consumers, Dominos does not condone this behaviour and Domino's Pizza LLC and the store franchisee are taking legal action against the former employees.

President of Domino's USA, Patrick Doyle has responded to the video, apologising for the incident and describing the steps Domino's will take to ensure a similar incident does not occur again (See <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7I6AJ49xNSQ>).

Domino's globally takes these matters extremely seriously and has a strict code of conduct in place which employees must adhere to.
