## **Levin community supported by Dough Raisers**

Domino's Pizza Levin is getting in behind the local community with a series of Dough Raisers planned for the coming weeks.

The events, held every Wednesday, will see \$1 of every pizza sold between 5pm and 8pm donated to a different cause each week.

Domino's Levin store owner Mike Orchard has been running Dough Raisers since June 2008 and has raised more than \$3,600 for 32 local schools, clubs and other groups.

"The staff are thrilled to be able to support such a range of Levin organisations. It's been really important for us to give something back to the community who have been so supportive of us," says Orchard.

On September 9<sup>th</sup> a Dough Raiser will be held for the Foxton Cadet and Calvinett Club. One of the club's missions for 2009 is to support Tear Fund's Micro Enterprise programme in Cambodia. The programme helps people in developing countries become self sufficient by loaning them funds to start a business. As they start earning, the loan is paid back.

Other upcoming Dough Raisers will assist the Horowhenua Under 13 Girls Soccer Team travel to a Wellington tournament, Otaki Taekwondo purchase new jigsaw training mats, Parsons Avenue Kindergarten purchase a purpose-built aluminium ladder for outdoor play and Ohau School in fundraising for a new playground.

A recent Dough Raiser supported local girl Jaide Pearson (8) to fly to Mexico for stem cell treatment this month. The local community has generated over \$30,000 of the \$40,000 required to fund the treatment through numerous fundraising events and donations.
